Haskell Indian

In 1884, twenty-two Native American children entered the doors of a new school in Lawrence, Kansas to begin an educational program which focused on agricultural education in grades 1 through 5. Today, Haskell Indian Junior College continues to serve the educational needs of Native American people from across the United States. For over 107 years, Native Americans have been sending their children to Haskell and Haskell has responded by offering curricula innovative and oriented toward Native American culture.

The doors to Haskell officially opened in 1884 under the name of the United States Indian Industrial Training School. Enrollment quickly increased from its original 22 to over 400 within one semester's time. The early trades for boys included tailoring, wagon-making, blacksmithing, harness-making, painting, shoe-making, and farming. Girls studied cooking, sewing, and home-making. Most of the student's food was produced on the Haskell farm and students were expected to participate in various industrial duties.

Only ten years before the school expanded its academic training beyond the eighth grade, a "normal school" was added because teachers were needed in the students' home communities. The commercial department, now the business department, opened in 1895 with five typewriters. It is believed that the first touch-typing class in Kansas was taught at Haskell.



Junior College

By 1927, the secondary curriculum has been accredited by the State of Kansas and Haskell began offering post-high school courses in a variety of areas. Part of Haskell's attraction was not only the post-high school courses, but its success in athletics. Haskell football team in the early 1900's to the early 1930's are legendary. And even after the 1930's, when the emphasis on football began to decrease, athletics remained a high priority to Haskell students and alumni. Today, Haskell continues to pay tribute to the great athletes by serving as the home of the American Indian Athletic Hall of Fame.

Industrial training became an important part of the Haskell curriculum in the early 1930's and by 1935 Haskell began to evolve into a post-high school vocational-technical institution. The secondary program was gradually phased out and the last high school class graduated in 1965. The school began the process of converting to a junior college. In 1970, Haskell Institute officially became Haskell Indian Junior College.

Today, in 1993, Haskell Indian Junior College has an average enrollment of over 900 students each semester. These students represent 140 tribes from 32 states and are as culturally diverse as imaginable. Students select the program which will prepare them to transfer to a baccalaureate degree granting institution or to enter directly in employment. Haskell has continued to integrate an emphasis on Native American culture into all of its curricula. This focus of the curriculum in addition to its intertribal constituency makes Haskell unique and provides exciting challenges in moving Haskell into the 21st century.



Board of Regents

The Board of Regents functions as the policy-making board for Haskell. The Board, which represents a nationwide constituency, serves to insure the availability and quality of all educational programs and to provide an environment which meets the needs of students for development as wholesome individuals. The 15-member board is selected by their respective representational areas and are enrolled tribal members. Areas representation on the Board include 12 administrative geographical areas as determined by the Bureau of Indian Affairs with an additional regent being selected by the four tribes of Kansas. The two remaining members of the Board are the National Haskell Alumni President and the Haskell Student Senate President.



President's Message

Haskell is an intertribal college that has provided high quality education to Native Americans for more than 109 years. As a result, the Haskell tradition represents excellence in Native American education -- an education that is culturally based and prepares students for success in the contemporary world, while increasing appreciation of Native culture.

During the 1992-93 school year, you have continued this tradition of excellence, as evidenced by your achievements in academics, athletics and your demonstrated leadership in student organizations. For example, the number of honor roll students has continued to increase and the football team's winning record is a tribute to the players' commitment to excellence. In addition, an increasing number of student organizations has provided student leadership in improving the quality of life on campus. A few of these organizations include the Haskell Student Senate, UNITY, Phi Beta Lambda, the Navajo Club, the Kiowa Club, the Apache Club, the Haskell Singers and Dancers, AISES, and the Wesley Foundation. Accordingly, you have made a difference at Haskell, and I thank all of you for your contributions.

As future alumni, you are a permanent part of the Haskell family and I hope this is just the beginning of a lifetime association with the college. I wish you the best of luck as you pursue your dreams for the future.

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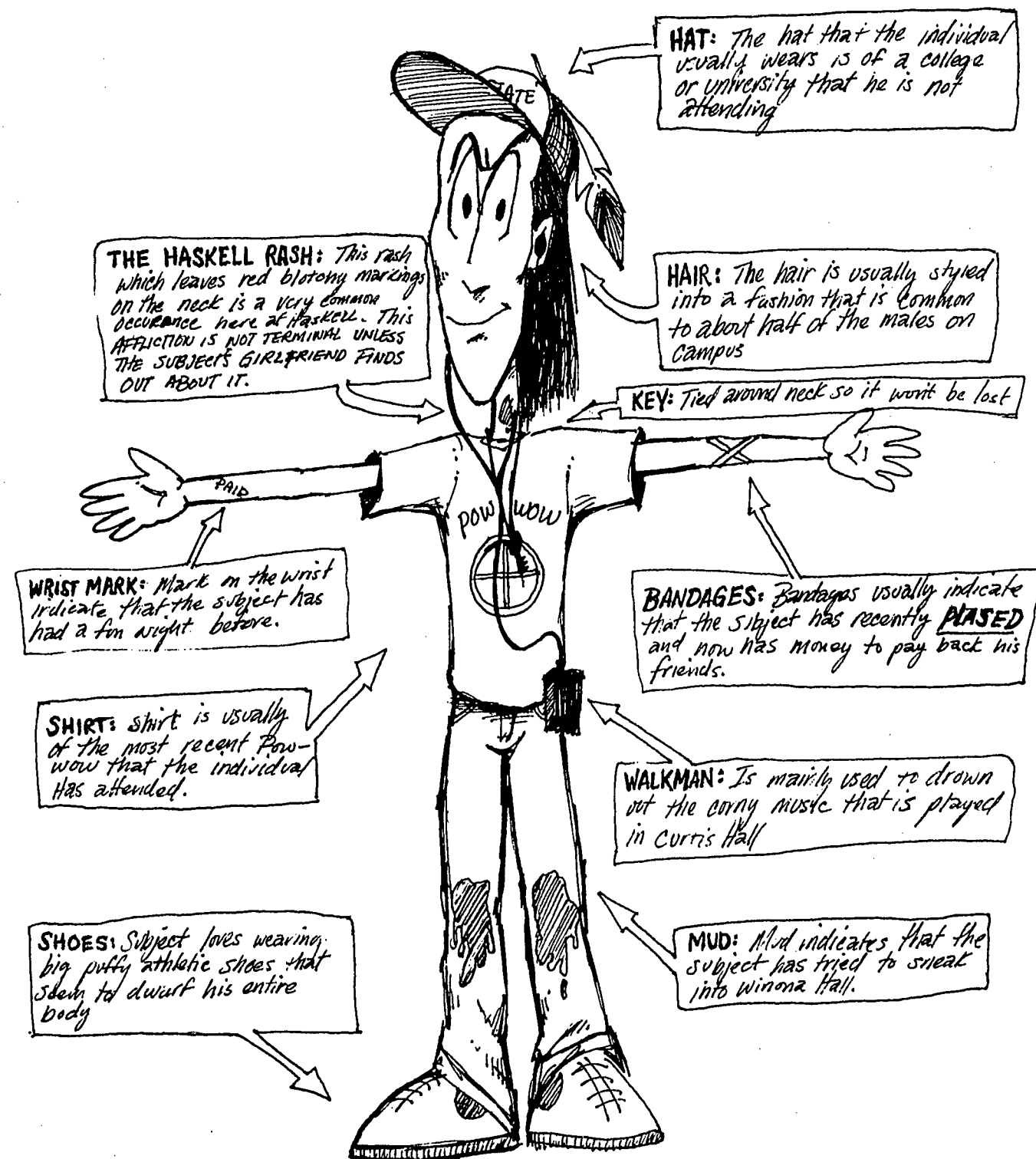
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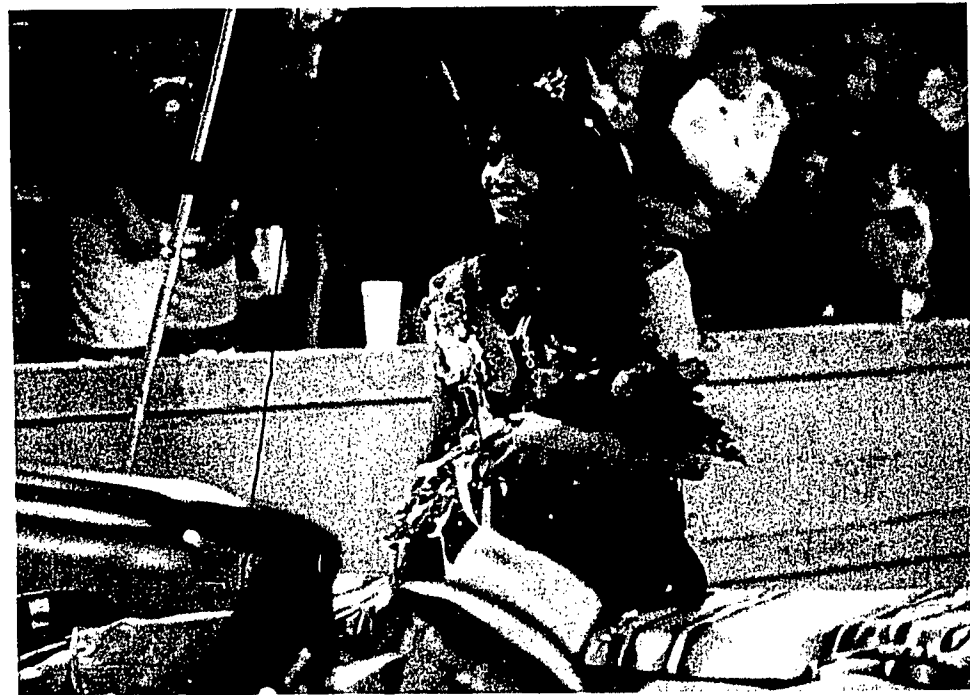


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ANATOMY OF A HASKELL STUDENT 1993. (MALE)

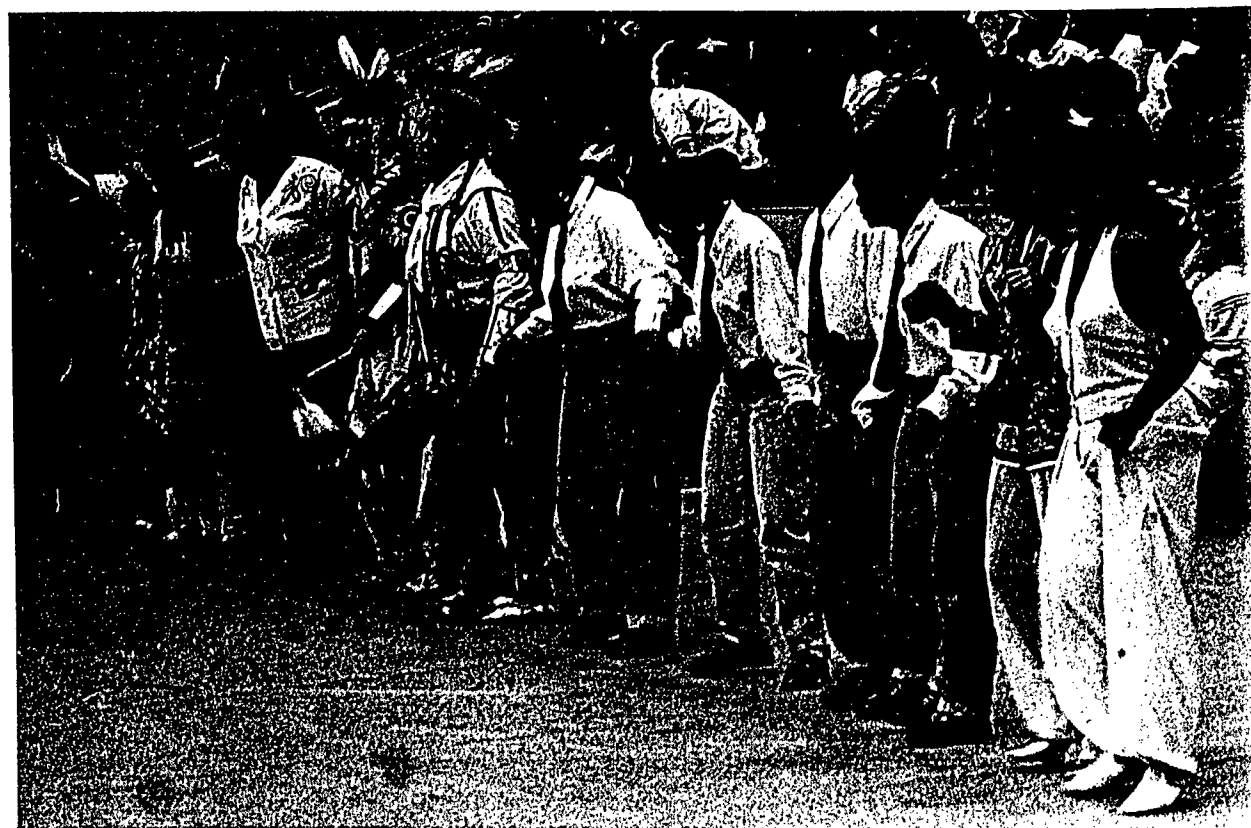
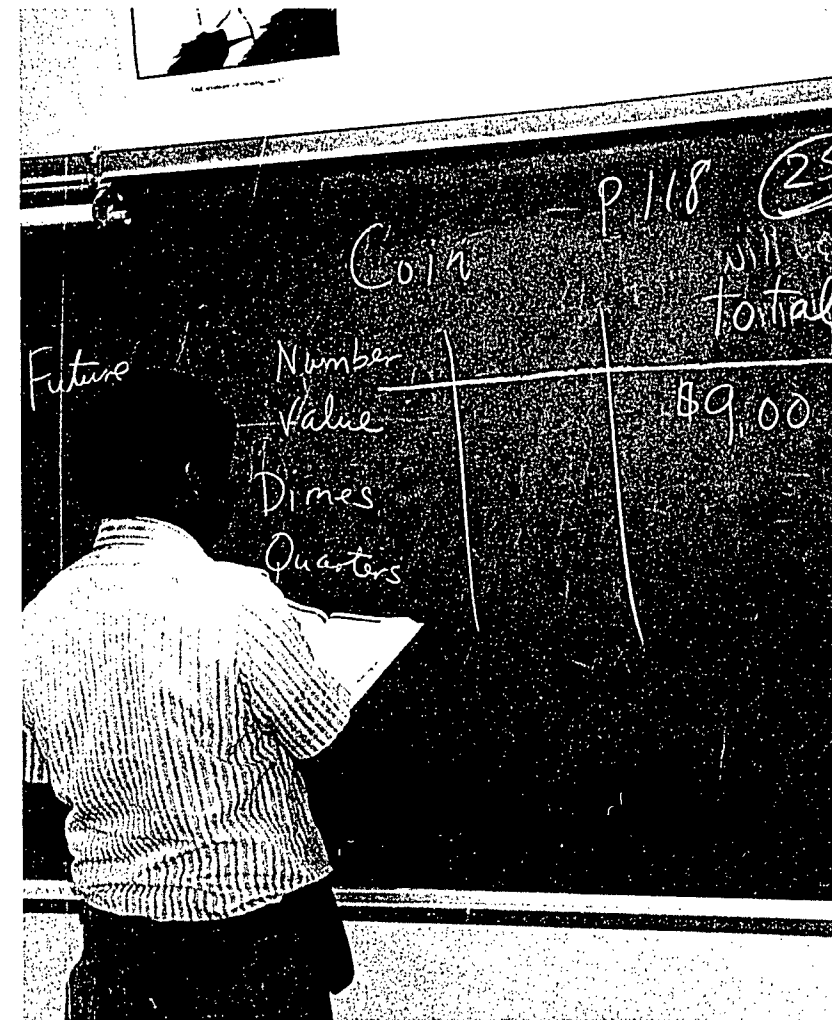
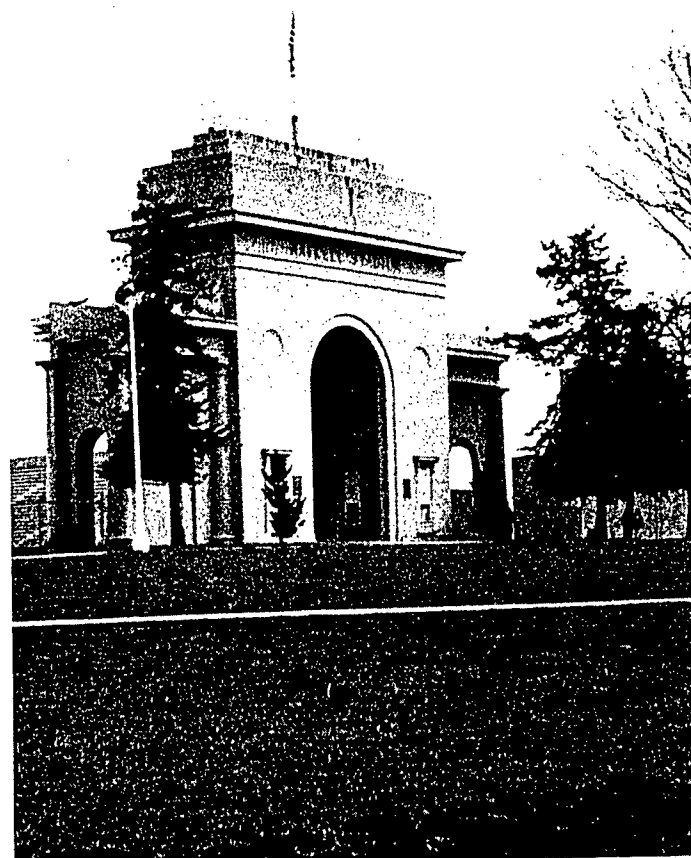

Ruth Ann Hawkins, English teacher and tutor, vice-president of the National Federation of Federal Employees (NFFE), and Haskell advocate, passed away at her home on October 31, 1992.

Ruth was born in Oklahoma City and was a member of the Chickasaw Nation. In 1957 she was adopted as a baby and raised by Patsy and Carl Warner in Miami, Oklahoma. As a child she was described as being small and ornery. This ornery disposition gave her the bulldog like trait that is known by those who disagreed with her.

In 1974 she received a degree in elementary education and earned her Masters degree from Oklahoma State University in 1976. Besides teaching at Haskell, Ruth has also taught at Riverside School in Anadarko, Oklahoma and Sitka, Alaska.

Ruth was concerned for the rights of Native Americans and was admired for her strong convictions and her ability to carry them out. She cared for the students at Haskell and continued to work with students even after being diagnosed with terminal liver cancer. Ruth loved to teach and continued to do so until she was not longer able.

Ruth is greatly missed here at Haskell especially by those of us who knew her. She helped all who went to her whether it was an English essay, labor dispute or just an honest opinion on a subject or an issue. She was a teacher, a mediator and an advocate.
